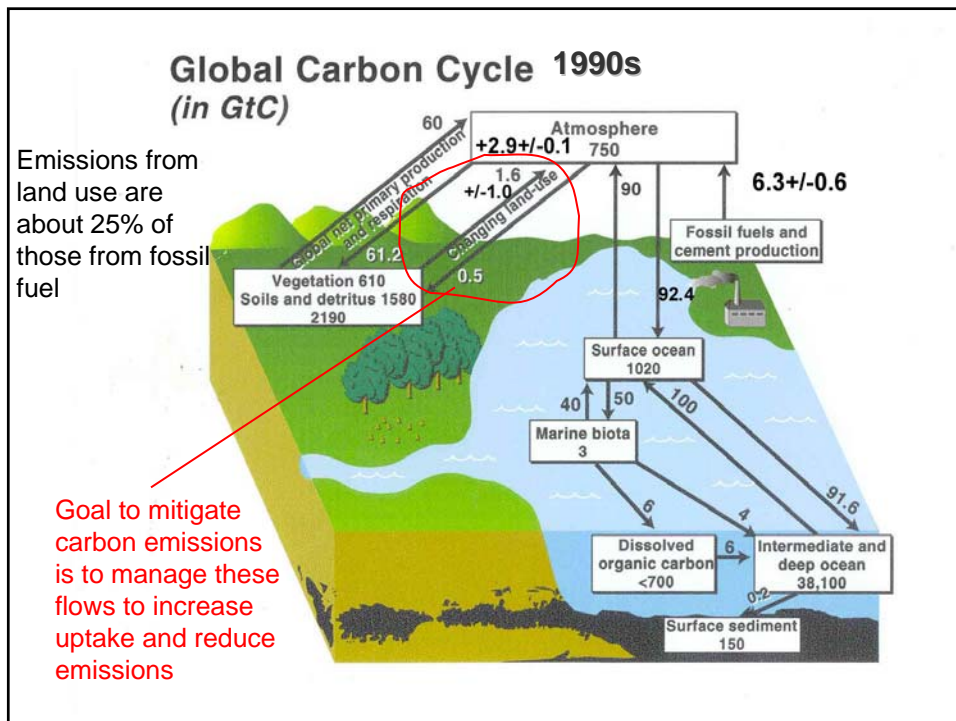



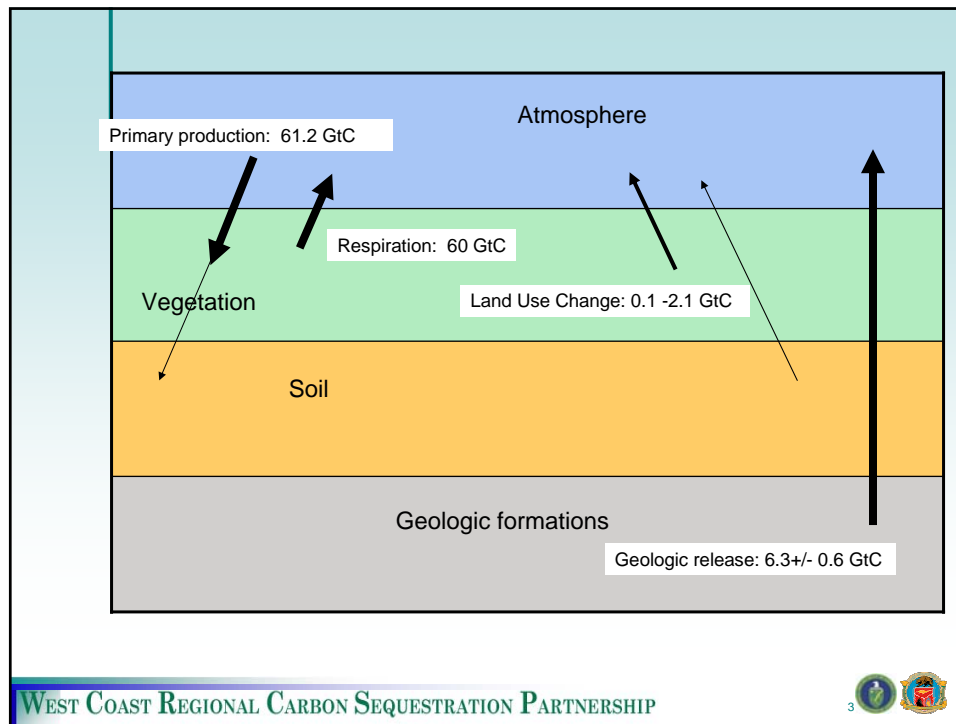

WESTCARB Phase II Overall Objectives

- Demonstrate ways to sequester carbon dioxide and reduce emissions of greenhouse gases linked to global warming
- Validate the carbon sequestration opportunities identified in Phase I through pilot projects, methodology development, reporting, and market recognition
- Research to inform decisions by policymakers, communities, and businesses on how to invest in CCS technology development and deployment to achieve climate change mitigation objectives
