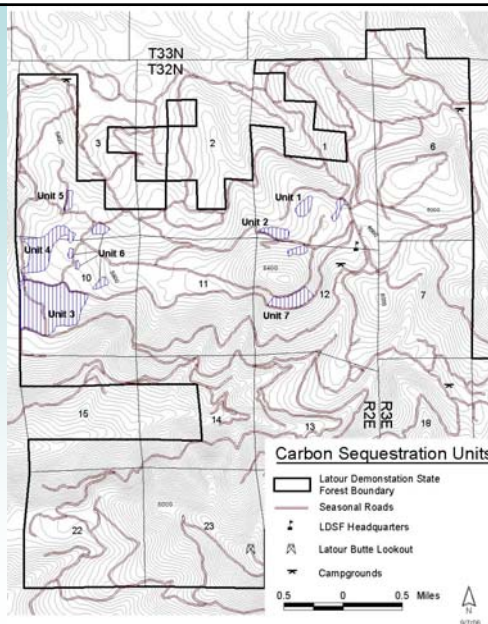


Vegetation Treatments

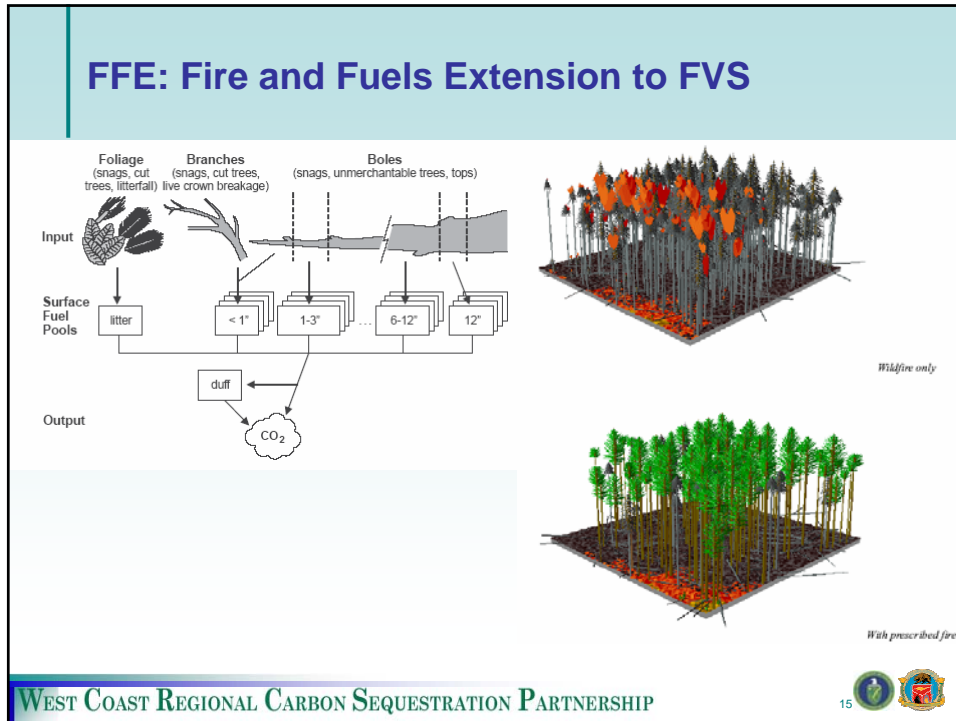


Reforestation
